






NavGurukul

NavGurukul runs a one-year residential course for young women from underserved and diverse communities. Students after pursuing their course are awarded a Diploma in Software Programming issued by the Directorate General of Training, Government of India.

NavGurukul's focus area is to provide higher education linked strongly to the employability of the marginalized so that they can have access to aspirational jobs like Software Engineering and Analytics. Higher education of the marginalized doesn't just help these students but it also creates problem solvers within the communities. The residential program enables them to become financially comfortable, equips them with confidence and provides a practical exposure to solve real-world problems.

KPMG Global Delivery Center Private Limited (GDCPL) has partnered with NavGurukul to set up a Bengaluru campus for girl students from different parts of India. This will help the youth, especially women, gain access to aspirational careers that would have otherwise been difficult to achieve.



The Forward Foundation

Rain water harvesting (RWH) involves collection of rainwater and its storage for on-site reuse or recharging of ground water through recharge pits. The aim of rain water harvesting is to minimize the surface runoff and maximize the usage of rain water/recharge ground water table as there is increased depletion of ground water in urban areas because of ever growing demand of water due to higher density of population and associated developments including industries.

GDCPL has partnered with The Forward Foundation to implement and install rain water harvesting set-ups in three government schools.



Surud Foundation

Surud Foundation is a purpose-driven social organization working towards elimination of poverty, hunger and road accidents. They are also aimed at improving education, skill development, entrepreneurship etc.

GDCPL has partnered with Surud Foundation to implement projects focusing on environmental sustainability.

Our colleagues can volunteer to participate in a range of activities such as making seedballs/seed-bombs, educating children on waste management and crop cultivation by setting up a composting plant and kitchen gardens in government schools.



Don Bosco India

Don Bosco is a Kochi-based NGO that reaches out to and rescues children and at-risk youth with an objective to protect them, educate them, rehabilitate them; and to inspire them towards realizing their full potential.

GDCPL supports skill development, remedial classes, extracurricular activities, scholarships and nutrition programs of youths residing at the Vasalsalya Bhavan Annexe and the Home for the Boys.



The/Nudge Foundation

The/Nudge Foundation is one of our partner NGOs based in Bengaluru. It focuses on sustainable poverty alleviation by building a strong 360-degree life, learning and economic foundation that equips the ultra-poor to escape the cycle of poverty.

GDCPL supports the Ultra-Poor Program in three districts of Jharkhand – Lohardaga, Latehar and Gumla. The main objective of the program is to work with women belonging to families of the ultra-poor population in Jharkhand and help develop their livelihood skills such as agriculture, livestock and small trade. In addition, wherever possible, we aim to help them build kitchen gardens that can be used to meet their family’s nutritional requirements as well as generate some income.
