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KPMG reports: California (goodwill); Louisiana (sales tax, online sales)

KPMG's This Week in State Tax—produced weekly by KPMG's State and Local Tax practice—focuses on recent state and local tax developments.

- **California:** The Office of Tax Appeals concluded that shareholders of an S corporation must apportion their pro-rata share of the gain realized on the S corporation's sale of goodwill using the S corporation's factors.
- **Louisiana:** A state appeals court held that sales and use taxes related to online sales were to have been remitted to the local (parish) tax authority instead of to the state-level Department of Revenue.
