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## IRS Priority Guidance Plan for 2020-2021

The IRS and U.S. Treasury Department this week released the 2020-2021 Priority Guidance Plan.

The Priority Guidance Plan is used each year to identify and prioritize tax issues to be addressed through regulations, revenue rulings, revenue procedures, notices, and other published administrative guidance.

The 2020-2021 [Priority Guidance Plan](#) [PDF 169 KB] identifies guidance projects that the IRS and Treasury Department intend to work on as priorities during the 12-month period from July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021. There are 191 guidance projects on the 2020-2021 priority guidance plan, and as of September 30, 2020, 57 guidance items have been released.

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
